# Where is the performance?

I'm going to a performance at QPAC! It's a large, cement building in South Bank.

There are a number of theatres within the building.  
The show I'm seeing is in the Concert Hall.

# Crowd and Audience

There will be lots of people in the room (up to 1500!) to watch the show. I have a ticket with an allocated seat, so I don't need to worry about having a seat - it's already booked. There are seats at the stage level, as well as a balcony above. There might be people sitting next to me that I don't know.





# The Performance

The performance will happen on the stage.

It's going to be music by the famous singer Adele (but it won't be the real Adele onstage).

The lights will dim and bright lights will shine onto the stage so we can see the performers clearly.  
There will be lots of changes of the lights throughout the show.

There will also be music played by a 20-piece band and singing by 4 vocalists.





# The Performance

In the band there will be a drum kit, grand piano, guitar, bass guitar, 12 strings players and 3 singers. Everyone plays together throughout the performance.

Because of the instruments and microphones it might be loud at times. I can bring my headphones to wear if it becomes too overwhelming.





# Interval

Half way through the show there will be an interval, or a short break, for about 20 minutes.

I can go to the bathroom, get a drink or snack and stretch my legs during this time.

When it's time to go back into the theatre I'll hear a bell sound over the speaker foyer.





# The Cast

This is Naomi Price.

She will be the main singer in the show.

Because the show is celebrating Adele's music,  
she will be pretending to be Adele.

She'll tell stories and sing all of the songs.

There may be some coarse language and  
outrageous jokes.
