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# Welcome from QPAC

Play the first ten seconds of Randy Newman's *You've Got a Friend in Me* to just about any child born since 1995, or their parents, and they'll immediately recognise it as the opening song to the Pixar classic, *Toy Story*. The jaunty woodwinds and gloriously off-kilter honky tonk piano immediately conjures visions of Woody being flung about with cheerful abandon, surviving stair banisters, gravity and Andy's enthusiasm with equal good humour.

Newman's genius lies in how precisely the music mirrors the film's tone: it's warm and generous, with just enough sideways glance to keep things honest. The score doesn't merely accompany what's happening on screen, through deceptively simple melodies and mischievously pointed lyrics, the music gives the toys their voice and personality, landing emotional moments with authenticity and charm, never lapsing into earnestness.

*Toy Story* marked Pixar's first full soundtrack release, and Newman's music set a template that many films have since followed. First released in 1996 on cassette and CD (in a pre-streaming world that now feels almost comically distant), the soundtrack has proven remarkably durable. Its charm hasn't faded; if anything, its clarity and good humour remain wonderfully intact.

What makes this music so enduring is its ability to delight across ages. Kids respond to its bounce and colour, adults appreciate Newman's sly humour, and everyone enjoys hearing an orchestra having a little fun. We're thrilled to present *Toy Story in Concert* in partnership with Queensland Symphony Orchestra, and we hope this performance brings plenty of laughs, lightness and perhaps a renewed appreciation for just how much personality can fit into a few well-placed notes.

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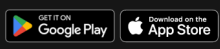
